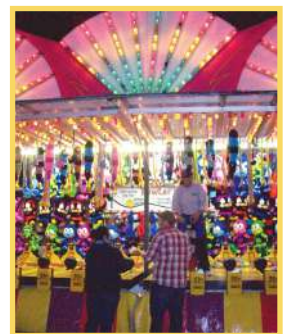
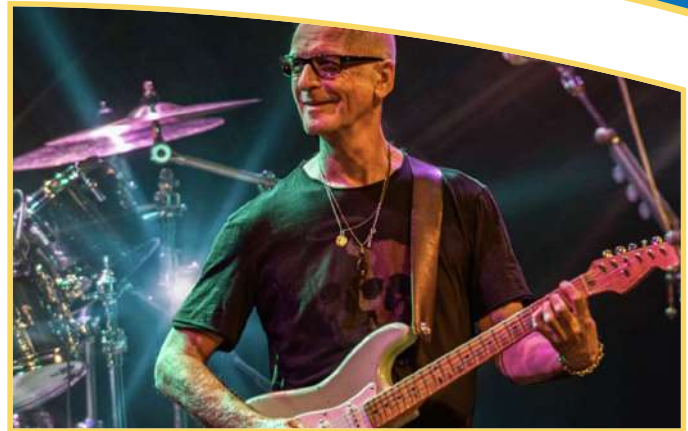
Festivals and Events

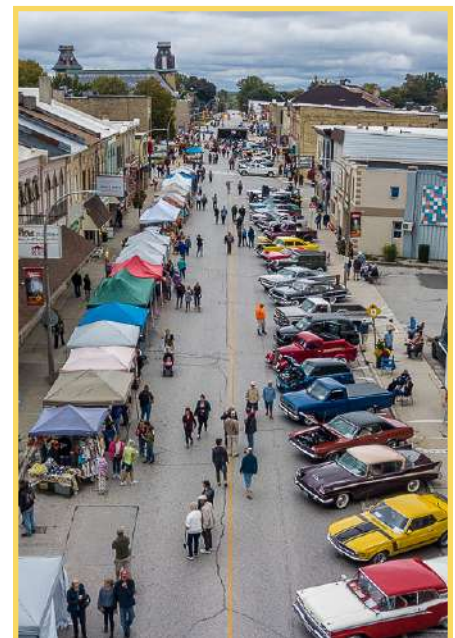
The fair occurs annually on the first weekend in June. Visit the Clinton Spring Fair website to see this year's dates and events.

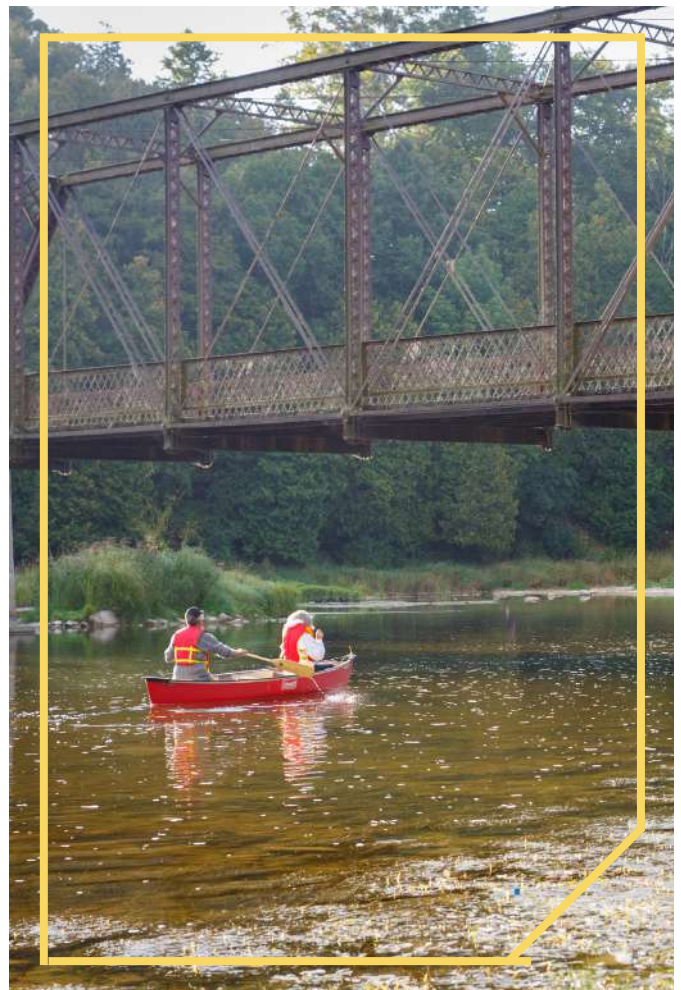
Ball's Bridge

38199 Little Lakes Rd, Goderich

Ball's Bridge was erected in 1885 to connect Goderich, the county seat, with outlying areas to the east. The structure is an excellent – and now rare – example of a two-span Pratt design through truss, pin-connected wrought iron bridge. Its construction shows attention to detail through the 'v-lacing' located on the bridge.

According to Daryl Ball, a descendant of the family who farmed the land, a young Miss Ball had to cross the river by foot to go to market in Goderich. During one trip to buy sugar, she was spotted by an engineer who was employed to supervise construction of the Goderich Bridge. They fell in love and he built Ball's Bridge one summer so that his love would be able to cross without getting wet. Since then, Ball's Bridge has been dubbed "The Bridge That Love Built" and is arguably the most romantic bridge in Ontario.

History and Attractions



Radar

Intersection of Hwy 8 and Hwy 4

Perched at the junction of Highways 4 and 8 at the heart of Clinton is the iconic radar antenna that identifies the area as 'The Home of Radar' in Canada. From 1941-1972, a secret radar training school outside of town trained 150,000 people in radar technology for WWII and the Cold War. Today, the town of Vanastra stands where the RCAF Clinton airbase used to be. The antenna was part of a long range radar system developed during the Cold War to detect inbound Soviet aircraft or missiles.

CNR School on Wheels

76 Victoria Terrace, Clinton

In 1926, Clinton locals, Fred and Cella Sloman, set off on a new school railcar program designed to bring education to remote northern families. During this time, most northern children received little to no formal education. This Canadian National Railway car was transformed into a classroom with living quarters in the back half to house the Slomans and their five children. The Sloman railcar became one of seven school cars used in the north over a 41 year period from 1926-1967. Today, it is a museum open seasonally.

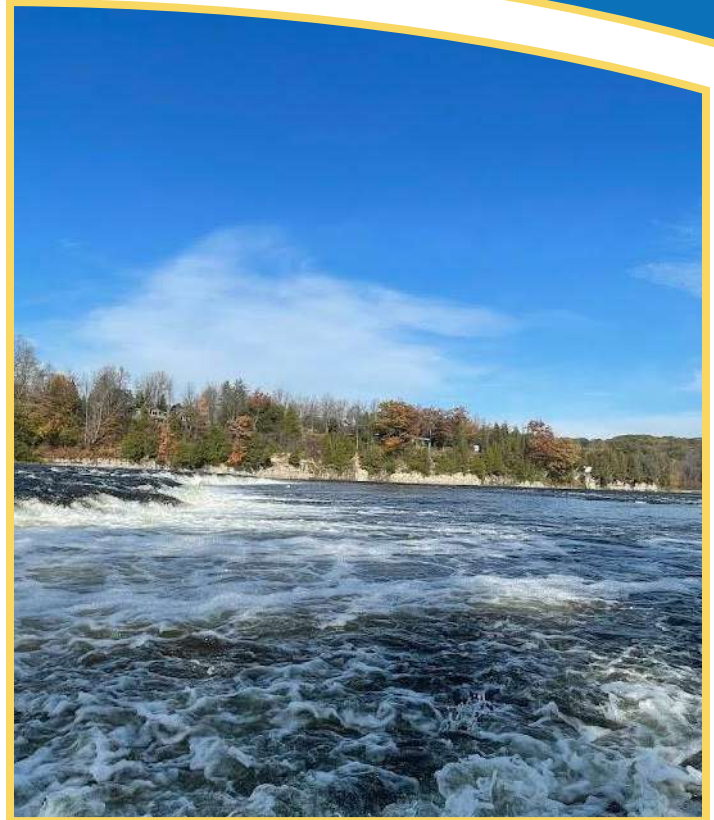
Home on the Range

Harbour Lights Marina

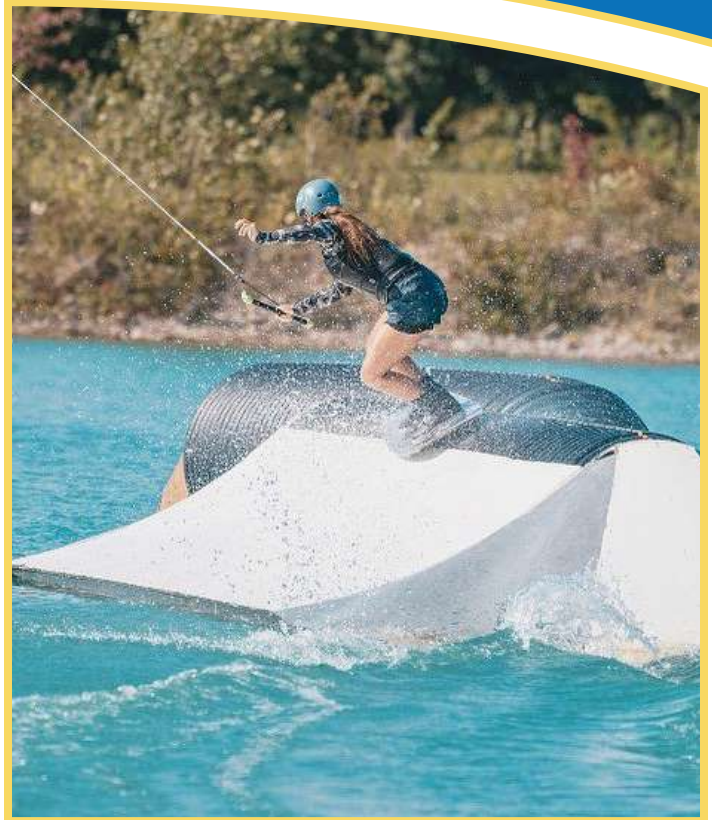
Chart House Hill, Bayfield

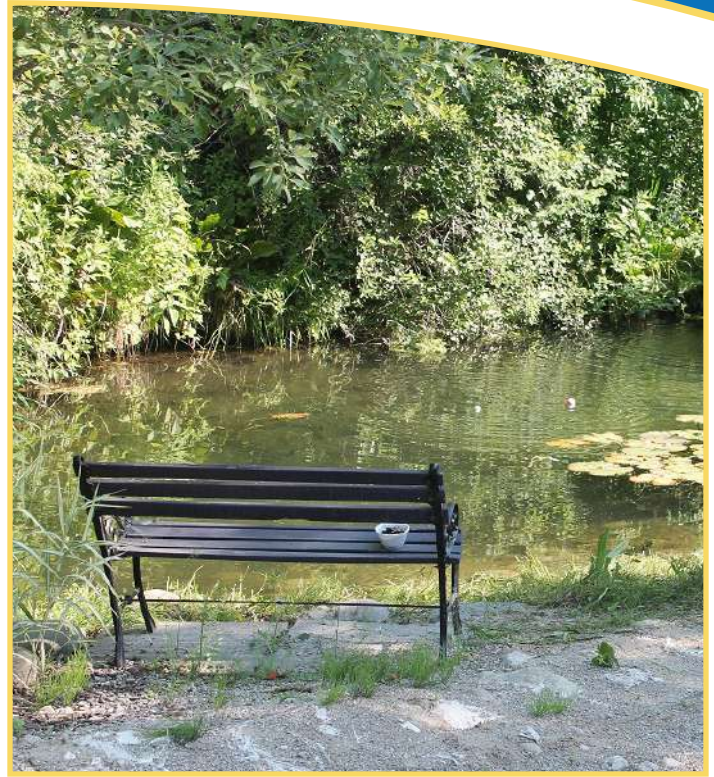

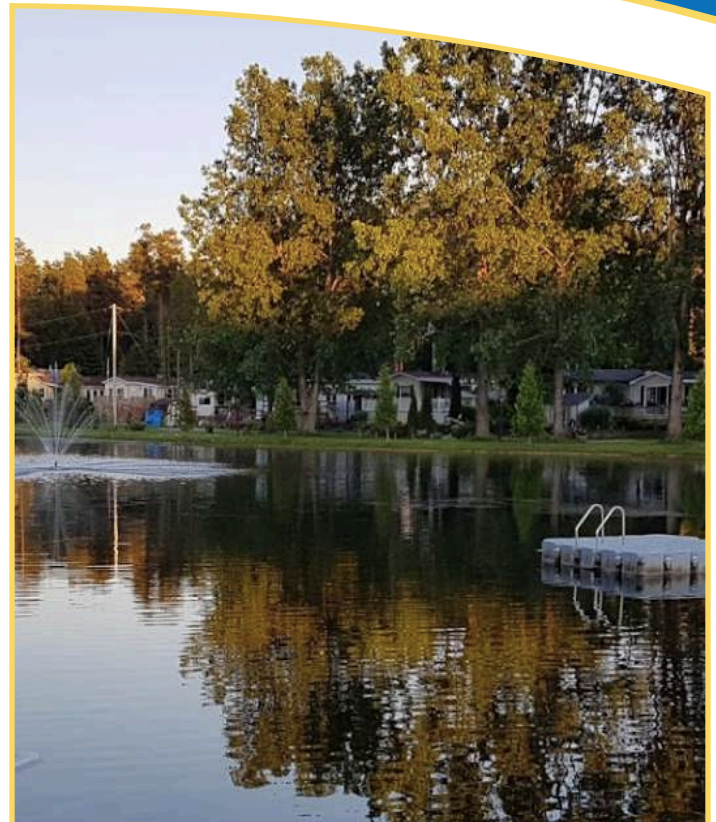
